**Days of Operation:** Sunday through Saturday

**Rental Hours:** between 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM

**Rates:**

\$250	2-hour rental
\$400	4-hour rental
\$700	full-day rental

**All rentals include:** Set-up of tables and chairs.  
*(maximum capacity in the Lodge is 80 guests; Cantina is 40 guests)*  
Paper table clothes, white  
1/2 hour pre-rental set-up time

**Requirements:** Payment due in full 10 days prior to the event.  
***Make checks payable to: Preserve Putnam/TFFM***

\$75 deposit and signed rental agreement are required to hold your reservation. An inspection of the facility will be made after your event. Should the facility not be returned in the condition it was found, the Tilly Foster Farm Museum reserves the right to charge any additional clean-up or maintenance fees against the deposit. The deposit will be mailed back one week after the event.

**No Alcohol.**

**No candles and/or open flames.**

**No tape or other adhesives may be used on any surface.**

Garbage must be placed in receptacles provided.

**Additional Options:** Pony rides for up to 10 youth guests may be provided for an additional fee of \$125.

Historic tour of Tilly Foster may be provided for an additional fee of \$75.

### Tilly Foster Farm General Information

Tilly Foster Farm is home to a unique collection of rare and endangered Early American farm animals. In 2008, Randall Lineback Cattle, American Sheep and a Mammoth Jackstock Donkey were introduced. Visitors can also enjoy Narragansett Turkey, Delaware Chickens, Indian Runner Duck, Guinea Hogs and American Blue Rabbits. These animals are all listed on the American Livestock Breeders Conservancy's endangered list and are critical in the efforts to conserve historic breeds and genetic diversity in livestock. The public is welcome to visit the farm free of charge, seven days a week from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Tilly Foster Farm Museum is managed by the Whipple Foundation / Society for the Preservation of Putnam County Antiquities and Greenways, a 501 (c) 3 tax exempt organization.
